

What is DC HealthCare Alliance?

The DC Healthcare Alliance (Alliance) is a free program that gives residents of the District of Columbia an opportunity for better healthcare. Uninsured individuals and immigrant families that are not eligible for Medicaid may be eligible. Enrollment is simple, all that is needed to determine eligibility is a completed program application with proof that the applicant: lives in the District of Columbia, the total income is within the guidelines set for the program, and the applicant does not have other health insurance coverage. Once enrolled, Alliance members are assigned to a Primary Care Physician and the member will be able to receive reliable and full-service medical care from many neighborhood clinics and hospitals in the District of Columbia.
