HISTORY AND BACKGROUND

1985 -Unity founded as "Health Care for the Homeless Project (HCHP).

1996 -The Federal Government requested that HCHP become the emergency grantee for the Community Health Center Program [Section 330 (3)] in the District of Columbia.

1997 - HCHP changed its name to Unity Health Care, Inc.

2001 - Unity Health Care joined the DC Health Care Alliance.

2005 - Unity celebrated 20 years of Service.

2006 - Unity starts to provide health services to the District of Columbia's Department of Correction Incarcerated population.

2007 - Establishment of Unity Health Care's Foundation (The Foundation)

2009 - Unity Health Care implements Electronic Medical Records
